Angliss Neighbourhood House courses are for people who are keen to improve their reading, writing, listening and speaking skills. We offer people the chance to learn and practice their English skills in a comfortable, informal and relaxed atmosphere at a low cost. Students will have the opportunity to improve their reading and writing skills for day to day life, for employment or for further study. New students can enter the class at any time (if there is a place available). As a small, friendly and accessible neighbourhood house we are well placed to support your individual learning needs and to assist you in achieving the best possible learning outcomes. The administration and teaching staff will make every effort to provide you with relevant information about course selection and ongoing training options.

Classes run all year round on a school term basis and if you would like to enrol in a class you will need to make an appointment for an assessment. All new students need to make an appointment and be interviewed to ensure they are placed in a suitable class. In 2018 accredited courses offered are 22250VIC Certificate 1 in EAL Framework (Access) and 22251VIC Certificate 2 in EAL Framework (Access).

Pre-accredited classes are funded through the Adult Community and Further Education Board and are provided for students at minimal cost (phone 9687 9908 for details).
